The Real Birth Workshop currently offers the following accessibility functions:

- Text reflows up to 200% zoomed in (the maximum amount)

- Navigation of the entire website using just a keyboard
- Full functionality of the workshop on all current mobile device operating systems
- Program availability in Portrait and Landscape modes

The workshop has been written in an easily understandable style with common phraseology and in eight humanly translated languages.
